The Hockley Historic Community Hall & Church buildings remain closed to events, rentals, and gatherings due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We are continuing to work with our local public health unit to make a responsible decision as to when reopening our buildings will be deemed safe. We are somewhat optimistic a late spring/early summer reopening may be possible as the province has indicated they will probably be loosening restrictions over the next several months, but our reopening date cannot be confirmed at this time. 
